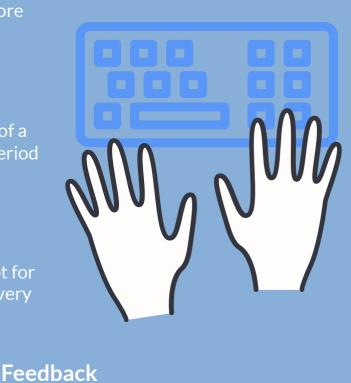


Application is valid for the organisation of a single course module for the specified period (but can have multiple sessions).
